Minimum Wage Order 2024

Portfolio Workplace Relations and Safety

On 22 February 2024, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that, on 30 January 2024, Cabinet agreed to:
 - 1.1 increase the adult minimum wage rate from \$22.70 per hour to \$23.15 per hour;
 - 1.2 maintain the starting-out and training minimum wage rates at 80 percent of the adult minimum wage rate;

[CAB-24-MIN-0016]

- 2 **noted** that as a result of the decision referred to in recommendation 1.2 above, the startingout and training minimum wage rates will increase from \$18.16 per hour to \$18.52 per hour;
- noted that the Minimum Wage Order 2024 gives effect to the decisions referred to in paragraph 1 above;

- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Minimum Wage Order 2024 [PCO 26108/3.0];
- 6 **noted** that the Minimum Wage Order 2024 comes into force on 1 April 2024.
