

#### Background

- On 15 April 2019 Cabinet agreed that the Immigration (International Visitor Conservation and Tourism Levy) Amendment Bill (the Bill) would be considered in the House under urgency on 30 May 2019 [CAB-19-Min-0174].
- On 21 May 2019 Cabinet Legislation Committee authorised the introduction of the Bill, and that the Minister of Immigration would lead the process of the Bill in the House [LEG-19-MIN-0067].

#### **Preparation for the House process**

- MBIE has prepared a folder of information to support you through the House process (Annex One). It contains:
  - a. An overview of the process
  - b. Speeches for the first, second and third reading (for the Minister of Immigration)
  - c. The Bill, and the clause by clause analysis of the Bill
  - d. Questions and answers for the Committee of the Whole
  - e. Departmental Disclosure Statement
  - f. Key briefings, Cabinet minutes and papers, and press releases.
- 4. Officials will brief the Minister of Immigration on the House process at the officials' meeting of Monday 27 May.
- 5. MBIE is also providing information to the Minister of Tourism to support any speeches he may wish to make during the debate on the Bill.
