UNHCR's submission

1. On 22 February 2016, the UNHCR provided for your consideration its submission on the 2016/17 to 2018/19 Refugee Quota planning cycle.

2. The UNHCR estimates that there are 20 million refugees, the highest global refugee population in 20 years. The number of refugees (1,150,300) considered to be in need of resettlement has surpassed one million for the first time since the resporting of resettlement needs began.

- 12. Thomas Albrecht has asked to meet with you to discuss the submission further "along with how best we can promote our mutual objectives with regard to New Zealand's resettlement programme, in particular as they relate to broader protection and solutions issues". This would be a further opportunity for you to discuss New Zealand's proposed approach to the next threeyear refugee programme, including the proposed new category Refugees outside the quota. The Ministry considers that it would be useful to meet with Mr Albrecht to keep the UNHCR fully appraised of New Zealand's proposals and "on board" with them.
- 13. Mr Albrecht has also referred in his letter to the 2017 Annual Tripartite Consultations on Resettlement, which New Zealand will be chairing next year. The Annual Tripartite Consultation on Resettlement is an annual meeting of governments, Non Government aren.
