5. Policy update

5.1 Centres of Vocational Excellence

The Minister of Education is lodging a Cabinet Paper on Centres of Vocational Excellence (COVEs) for consideration at Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee next week.

COVEs are one of seven changes to be introduced as part of the reform of vocational education. Their primary role is to drive innovation and excellence in vocational teaching and learning by strengthening links with industry and communities.

While much of the design work is still to be undertaken, we anticipate that there will be links with the skills and employment programme the PDU is leading, in particular jobs and skills hubs and Regional Investment Portfolios for Employment (RIPEs).

We will continue to work with the Ministry of Education and the Tertiary Education Commission to support their next steps, share lessons learned, and reduce duplication.
