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Updates

Funding to target improved skills and employment for Wairoa youth

On Tuesday 22 November 2017, in Wairoa, you:

- announced that \$150,000 of seed funding will be made available for the Wairoa community to target improved skills and employment for Wairoa youth; and
- advised that the funding would go to the Wairoa Community Partnership Group (WCPG) and acknowledged that any projects would need to meet a funding eligibility criteria.

On 14 December 2017 MBIE, TPK and Ministry of Social Development officials met the WCPG to hear the regions priorities and preferences and explain the process for accessing funding.

WCPG members identified the need for capability to support this proposal, and requested more time to consider project options. Senior Regional Officials (SRO) have approved funding (\$15,000), from MBJE Departmental to recruit a person to support the WCPG to develop a proposal and access funding.

Government agencies who attended the meeting, plus the Ministry for Rrinney Industries and Ministry of Education, have agreed to a collective impact approach (led by MBIE) to support this initiative.
