He Rangatahi, He anamata - Youth Leadership Summit 27th and 28th February 2018

The inaugural two day summit He Rangatahi, He Anamata brings together the next generation of leaders, iwi leaders, entrepreneurs and thought leaders to share, learn and explore leadership, pathways, innovation and enterprise for the long-term benefit of the Bay of Plenty region.

This year the summit will be hosted in Mount Maunganui where rangatahi will get to hear from a diverse range of speakers, take part in interactive workshops, participate in discussion forums, and will get the opportunity to mingle with peers, making new connections and expanding horizons. Speakers this year include Hon Nanaia Mahuta, Minister for Māori Development, Yoseph Ayele, CEO at Edmund Hillary Fellowship and Egan Brothers, Owners of creative agency Maui Studios.

Ultra-Fast Broadband Build Scheduling

In August 2017 the Ultra-Fast Broadband (UFB) programme was extended to cover an additional 193 towns, and the completion of the rollout was brought forward by two years from the then completion date of December 2024 to December 2022. This has meant that the build schedule has required revisions.

Chorus and Ultra-Fast Fibre (UFF) have been developing their deployment schedules in conjunction with their sub-contractor arrangements and resource scheduling to incorporate the new towns contracted for inclusion, as well as new build dates for those towns originally scheduled to receive UFB up to 2024.

The UFB partners will be advising local councils of the revised deployment schedule, as they need to liaise with councils regarding the civil works. To ensure you are informed ahead of councils, Crown Infrastructure Partners (CIP) will provide you and Minister Curran with a briefing next week outlining the deployment schedules finalised by Chorus and UFF together with the existing schedules for Northpower and Enable

CIP will not be making a media announcement on the scheduling, and it is unlikely that UFB partners will make a national media announcement.
