### Updates

#### **Regional GDP release next week**

Statistics New Zealand will release regional annual nominal total GDP figures for the year ended March 2017 on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2018. It will cover 15 main regions. A breakdown of regional GDP by industry will also be available for each year up to March 2016. The series starts in the year ended March 2000. We will provide you with a summary of the key points from the release in the following Weekly Report.

Once the regional GDP figures are released, MBIE will use the data to update its own Modelled Territorial Authority GDP estimates (MTAGDP). The MTAGDP estimates are released about two to three weeks after the regional GDP release. They give estimates of GDP for 66 Territorial Authority regions. A substantial update to the MTAGDP methodology is also underway. We intend to release the updated methodology and revised estimates with the next MTAGDP release.

#### **PGF Proposals - Update**

MBIE is managing the Provincial Growth Fund (PGF) (PGF@mbie.govt.nz) inbox. Since the launch of the PGF we have received over 54 enquiries and 18 proposals. We are asking Ministry for Primary Industries, NZTA and NZTE to share their proposals through the PGF inbox.

MPI is confirming their requirements, and MBIE IT is finalising the security risk assessment and accreditation of the database. The database will track the enquiries and allocate proposals to the appropriate person and agency. All government agencies will be able to access and we can track progress of enquiries and proposals through this portal. This is expected to be operational within one week.
