Industrial Symbiosis Kawerau – Industrial Subdivision Development							
Comment:	-						
Comment: The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) continues to support Industrial Symbiosis Kawerau (ISK) on the Industrial Subdivision Development that involves significant sector players (container terminal, wood processing, dairy processing and light engineering). The purpose of the development, which was presented to Minister Jones in December 2017, is to land an industrial subdivision with appropriate infrastructure in Kawerau to attract significant private sector investment. The proposed subdivision is largely based on Maori held land, but also has potential to partner with adjacent private sector and fland. Investment is required in rail and both public and private roading developments. PDU officials facilitated an all day workshop with key ISK Board members and fland. The outcome was to develop and agree an approach for the Provincial Growth Fund (PGF) with an 'Umbrella' Story and then stage the specific phases of the development over the next 12 months to the PGF. Skills and Employment within Provincial Development

Comment:

Work is underway within the PDU to examine options to utilise the PGF (mindful also of opportunities to align with wider Government priorities such as Future of Work and Education reviews) to get better work and economic outcomes whilst maximising the skills and employment dividend for New Zealanders in their regions, with a focus on surge regions and capacity gaps. These options will focus on:

- better co-ordination between the demand side (job opportunities for locals) resulting from PDU applications
- working with the various work readiness programmes (supply pipelines) to ensure they are connected to deliver on the opportunities at a regional level and able to be agile and fit for purposes in local contexts
 - providing tailored support for those who need more help to become work-ready for the job opportunities that will arise from the increased investment in those regions.
