Land Transport Amendment Regulations: Infringement Offence and Fees for Wheel Clamping Breach

Portfolio Commerce and Consumer Affairs

On 3 December 2019, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that on 8 August 2018, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee agreed to create an infringement offence for a breach that would otherwise give effect to an offence under the Land Transport (Wheel Clamping) Amendment Act 2019, with a maximum infringement fee of \$1,000 for an individual and \$5,000 for a body corporate [DEV-18-MIN-0153];
- 2 **noted** that the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Amendment Regulations (No 3) 2019 give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Amendment Regulations (No 3) 2019 [PCO 22510/8.0];
- 4 **poted** that the Regulations come into force on 10 January 2020.
