Applicant Organisation: Rangitikei District Council (RDC) Location: Marton Manawatu-Whanganui Proposal: Assist in the funding of an additional resource to develop and process RDC's pipeline of potential projects through to PGF application status. Funding Sought: Total project value: PGF Funding: PGF Funding: RDC has identified 8 potential projects that require further investigation and socialising with key stakeholders to determine whether investment in developing a business case is justified. RDC is a small local authority lacking the resources to actively progress these opportunities. The proposed projects are either covered in the Manawatu-Whanganui regional growth study/Accelerate 25 action plan, or have been socialised with the governance group.	 a) Note that the projects identified are all in various stages of assessment and require a dedicated resource to progress further. b) Note that both MPI and TPK have had some degree of engagement across the projects being developed. Both agencies support the allocation of funding and acknowledge the need for their continued guidance and support to ensure opportunities are progressed effectively. c) Note that the projects identified have the potential to lift the productivity in the regions however further work is required to substantiate benefits. d) Support the recommendation to Approve \$25,000 from the PGF fund towards the Rangitikei Capability Resourcing Project subject to: a. RDC's agreement to engage the appropriate Government agencies across each of the identified projects being assessed; and b. The decision to progress a project to an application for PGF funding of a feasibility or business case is to be supported by Accelerate 25 and PDU's Regional Advisor for Manawatu/Whanganui.

Risks Issues:

Engagement with key regional stakeholders. MBIE officials will continue to work with the RDC. The grant contract will include terms requiring alignment with the broader regional plan.

Eligibility points of note:

- Due diligence: Entity due diligence is not required as the applicant is a local authority
- Conflict(s) of interest: Based on the information provided no conflict of interest is evident noting that full due diligence will inform this item further.
- Illegal Activity: Based on the application information provided and feedback from other agencies there is no indication that the applicant or project has been involved in, or associated with illegal activity.
- Alignment with Regional development plans: The proposed orojects are either covered in the Manawatu-Whanganui regional growth study/Accelerate 25 action plan, or have been socialised with the governance group.
- Commercial funding availability: Given the nature of the project which is to fund a resource to progress
 identified projects to business case status access to commercial funding is not considered a feasible
 option.
