This upgrading will allow students (initially 24) to undertake field based and work specific training at Torere Macadamia.

The PDU has worked with the applicant to receive additional information relevant to this review, outlined above. Furthermore, MPI is continuing to work with Torere and will, if this application review is approved, oversee the conditions of approval.

SROs should note this is a business located on Maori land, making access to private sector funding more difficult to secure.

Torere Macadamias Ltd has submitted an 'Economic-investigation-and-research-fund' application to ECT for \$^{\text{Commercial MO}}\$, to produce the feasibility report on expanding the Torere nursery and proposed partnership with EIT to assist with plant production, and to integrate TML's Procedure Manuals for teaching resources to I/ZQA standards. This report will ensure that the proposed nursery and orchard expansion is commercially viable by improving plant and nut production while also delivering a work-based training facility. The report is being completed and this review decision should be contingent on analysis of that report.
