#### **Risks Issues:**

• The project may not be able to secure funding for the build phase after the completion of the business case without substantial PGF (or other government) funding.

- Illegal Activity:- Based on the application information provided and feedback from other agencies there is no indication that the applicant or project has been involved in, or associated with illegal activity.
- Alignment with Regional development plans:- Aligns with the Hawkes' Ray Economic Development Strategy
- Commercial funding availability:- Given the nature of the project which is a business case development access to commercial funding is not considered a feasible option.
