Napier to Wairoa variation for storm damage – Hawke's Bay

21. **Note** that in February 2018, RED Ministers agreed to fund \$5 million from the PGF to reinstate the Napier to Wairoa line bringing it up to a safe operating standard that is suitable for lower speed forestry traffic.

- 22. **Note** that in early March 2018, a localised weather event occurred in the area between Bayview and Tutira, with the Esk River breaking its banks. The event caused significant storm damage to the line and accordingly an additional \$1.2 million is sought from the PGF to fund these repairs. The total cost of the project is now \$6.2 million.
- 23. **Note** that PDU and the IAP recommend that RED Ministers support funding for \$1.2 million from the PGF towards addressing storm damage on the Napier to Wairoa line.
