Accident Compensation (Experience Rating) Amendment Regulations 2020

Portfolio ACC

On 18 February 2020, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that in December 2018, Cabinet agreed to enhancements to ACC's experience rating programme [CAB-18-MIN-0619];
- 2 **noted** that the Accident Compensation (Experience Rating) Amendment Regulations 2020 give effect to the above decisions:
- 3 **noted**:
 - 3.1 that sections 330 and 331 of the Accident Compensation Act 2001 require that, before recommending the making of regulations, consultation, recommendation, and reporting requirements must be met;
 - 3.2 (the advice of the Minister for ACC that all the requirements of sections 330 and 331 of the Act have been met;
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Accident Compensation (Experience Rating) Amendment Regulations 2020 [PCO 22639/5.0];
- 5 **noted** that the Amendment Regulations 2020 come into force on 1 April 2020.
