# **Telecommunications Relay Service: Increased Funding**

Portfolio Broadcasting, Communications and Digital Media

On 24 June 2020, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- **noted** that the Telecommunications Relay Service provides deaf, deafblind, hearing-impaired and speech impaired New Zealanders with the ability to communicate;
- noted that the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment has now completed a competitive procurement process, and has contracted Concentrix Services (New Zealand) Limited to supply an enhanced relay service from 1 February 2021;
- noted that the current relay service providers, Sprint International New Zealand and Communication Services for the Deaf, will continue to provide the relay service throughout the transition period to ensure service continuity;

- 5 **noted** that relevant Ministers have previously agreed to provide additional funding of \$0.7 million through a Fiscally Neutral Adjustment, and that this has been transferred to the relay service appropriation for the 2019/20 financial year;
- 6 **noted** that:
  - 6.1 there is a funding shortfall of \$2.056 million for the 2020/21 financial year due to the higher cost of transitioning to a new service while retaining an existing service to ensure service continuity;
  - this is an increase on the previously advised shortfall of \$1.8 million due to delays in essential work where costs will now be incurred in 2020/21;

- **noted** that the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment has identified areas of underspend in 2019/20 where funding could be reprioritised to meet the additional cost of services in 2020/21, if underspends are authorised to be reprioritised for the Telecommunications Relay Service (see paragraph 13 below);
- 8 **noted** that the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment seeks an inprincipal expense transfer for the delayed expense in essential work (see paragraph 6 above);
