INCIDENT REPORTS

25 July 2020 – Five people, one adult and four children, absconded from Hamilton's Distinction Hotel Managed Isolation Facility yesterday evening. A person was seen exiting over the facility fence at 7pm by the onsite police officer who immediately took action. Four of the five were detained in Hamilton at about 7.50pm last night. The fifth was located and detained at about 4.40am this morning without incident. Four of the five absconders have been charged with breaching the Health Act notice, and arrangements are being made for them to appear in court today.
