Total available capacity is 7,638. Effective capacity allows for 24 hour room turn-around between guests to allow for health and cleaning requirements between arrivals and departures. These requirements are much more thorough than a standard hotel room clean, and include the use of PPE equipment, sanitising and deep cleaning.

#### **Total planned capacity**

The 'total planned capacity increase' includes only those facilities that we have finalised formal arrangements with at the date of this report. MIQ are constantly monitoring the assigning of rooms to groups (for example, family groups) and the impact this has on average room occupancy. By comparing actual room occupancy to forecast room occupancy, we have adjusted our formula for average occupancy per room. As a result, our forecast for the number of spaces available in managed isolation facilities has increased.

### INCIDENT REPORTS

This section reports on any incidents in the last 24 hours that present a potential or actual risk to public health

2 August - A person accidentally exited the Managed Isolation Facility at the Crowne Plaza in Auckland via an emergency exit. The person was wearing a mask and returned directly to the facility when they realised their error moments later. The surfaces they touched have been disinfected and while we believe no contact occurred CCTV is being reviewed to ensure they did not encounter any members of the public.

2 August – A person deliberately entered the Managed Isolation Facility at the Novotel in Auckland attempting to meet their family members. The person did not come within two metres of any person within the facility. They were detained by Police, trespassed from the facility, and Police enquiries are continuing. They have been assessed as not being at risk of infection and were directed to self-monitor for symptoms and get tested if necessary.
