Total available capacity is 7,660. Effective capacity allows for 24 hour room turn-around between guests to allow for health and cleaning requirements between arrivals and departures. These requirements are much more thorough than a standard hotel room clean, and include the use of PPE equipment, sanitising and deep cleaning.

The 'total planned capacity increase' includes only those facilities that we have finalised formal arrangements with at the date of this report. MIQ are constantly monitoring the assigning of rooms to groups (for example, family groups) and the impact this has on average room occupancy. By comparing actual room occupancy to forecast room occupancy, we have adjusted our formula for average room occupancy per person. As a result, our forecast for the number of spaces available in managed isolation facilities has increased.

INCIDENT REPORTS

This section reports on any incidents in the last 24 hours that present a potential or actual risk to public health

08 August 2020 - A man breached security yesterday by allegedly forcing his way through outer 1.8m fencing at an Auckland managed isolation facility and having brief contact with a returnee who was in the exercise area. Police on site witnessed the incident and took immediate action to intervene, however the man fled the scene in a vehicle. He was arrested on 8 August and charged. The returnee involved tested negative at both their day three and day 12 tests and Health officials have determined the contact to be low risk. As with any breach of security an assessment of the incident is underway and we will consider whether any additional measures are required.
