Total available capacity is 7,625. Effective capacity allows for 24 hour room turn-around between guests to allow for health and cleaning requirements between arrivals and departures. These requirements are much more thorough than a standard hotel room clean, and include the use of PPE equipment, sanitising and deep cleaning.

#### **Total planned capacity**

The 'total planned capacity increase' includes only those facilities that we have finalised formal arrangements with at the date of this report. MIQ are constantly monitoring the assigning of rooms to groups (for example, family groups) and the impact this has on average room occupancy. By comparing actual room occupancy to forecast room occupancy, we have adjusted our formula for average room occupancy per person. As a result, our forecast for the number of spaces available in managed isolation facilities has increased.

## **INCIDENT REPORTS**

**12 August 2020** – Around 8:55pm yesterday a woman entered a staff area in the complex of an Auckland managed isolation facility after gaining entry through a faulty carpark door. Security footage has confirmed the woman did not enter any areas used by returnees and there was no close contact with anyone in managed isolation. The woman stopped immediately by staff and Police were alerted who arrested the woman on an outstanding warrant. The faulty door was immediately secured.
