Total available capacity is 7,625. Effective capacity allows for 24 hour room turn-around between guests to allow for health and cleaning requirements between arrivals and departures. These requirements are much more thorough than a standard hotel room clean, and include the use of PPE equipment, sanitising and deep cleaning.

The 'total planned capacity increase' includes only those facilities that we have finalised formal arrangements with at the date of this report. MIQ are constantly monitoring the assigning of rooms to groups (for example, family groups) and the impact this has on average room occupancy. By comparing actual room occupancy to forecast room occupancy, we have adjusted our formula for average room occupancy per person. As a result, our forecast for the number of spaces available in managed isolation facilities has increased.

INCIDENT REPORTS

This section reports on any incidents in the last 24 hours that present a potential or actual risk to public health

13 August 2020 – Around 8:45am yesterday a returnee briefly exited the boundary of a managed isolation facility in Auckland. The individual pushed past security, through a gated section of the facility's perimeter fence and walked approximately 10 metres outside the hotel boundary. Rapid action by the on-site security staff enabled the returnee to be verbally encouraged to return immediately to the facility. There was no contact with any member of the public and health officials have assessed there was no risk to public health during this brief incident.
