Participants will receive training and support towards gaining a Level 3 Certificate in Agriculture. Once completed, interns will be placed in full-time employment whilst completing a Level 4 Certificate in Agriculture over a further of the agriculture over a further period. Te Ara Mahi funding will be used towards administration, group activities, medical testing, accommodation allowances, uniforms, some training costs and pastoral care over the four year period while participants complete the Level 3 and 4 certificates. The pastoral care worker will provide full-time support to interns' transition to employment. The programme was developed in consultation with Northland Farmers, with more than expressing an interest and expressing indicating a commitment to become a hosting sponsor and future employer for interns. The programme will target NEETs of all ages, including school leavers and Ministry of Social Development (MSD) clients, specifically those who are most at risk of becoming long-term unemployed.
