2.1 Manawatū-Whanganui New Senior Regional Official

In the Manawatū-Whanganui region, Di Grennell, Senior Regional Official (SRO) has resigned from her role as Deputy Chief Executive Regional Partnerships at Te Puni Kōkiri, creating a vacancy in the SRO role. Whanganui Rail Upgrade	Due to COVID-19, this project missed an important opportunity to carry out works over Easter 2020 whilst the lines were closed. KiwiRail will need to schedule another four day closure at a later date, however this needs to be in line with their obligation to line users to keep the lines open. KiwiRail will need to assess the safety of their construction environment to adhere to guidelines for COVID-19 Alert Level 3 and PDU officials will work with KiwiRail to ensure the project progresses.
