





## 2017 Commercial Advisors Scheme: Approved Commercial Advisors

The Commercial Advisors listed below are approved to work with Māori Collectives in the 2017 round of the Commercial Advisors Scheme.

The Commercial Advisors in the list with an asterisk by their names were chosen by MBIE in 2014 through a competitive procurement process to serve as a pre-approved panel of providers for the first two rounds of the Commercial Advisors Scheme. They were selected for their broad commercial expertise and positive track record working with Māori businesses. The remaining Commercial Advisors in the list were approved by MBIE at the request of one or more collectives during the first two rounds of the scheme, and are now approved to work with any of the funded collectives in the 2017 round.

If you do not wish to work with any of the Commercial Advisors on this list, you may ask MBIE to approve a different Commercial Advisor to work with your collective. This request can be made as part of the online application process. Funded collectives who wish to have a non-list Commercial Advisor approved once their projects are underway can do so using the *Form to request approval of a Commercial Advisor*, available on the Commercial Advisors Scheme web page.
