Parental Leave and Employment Protection Amendment Regulations 2021

Portfolio Workplace Relations and Safety

On 10 February 2021, the Cabinet Business Committee:

- **noted** that on 1 July 2020, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee agreed to amend the Parental Leave and Employment Protection Regulations 2016 to enable online applications for paid parental leave [DEV-20-MIN-0129];
- authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Parental Leave and Employment Protection Amendment Regulations 2021 [PCO 23329/13.0];
- noted that a waiver of the 28-day rule is sought:
 - 3.1 so that the regulations can come into force by 1 March 2021;
 - 3.2 on the grounds that the change confers only benefits on the public;
- 4 **agreed** to waive the 28-day rule so that the regulations can come into force on 1 March 2021;
- 5 **noted** that the Parental Leave and Employment Protection Amendment Regulations 2021 will be gazetted on 18 February 2021 and come into force on 1 March 2021.
