

INCIDENT REPORTS AND KEY MESSAGES

This section reports on any incidents in the last 24 hours that present a potential or actual risk to public health and any key messages about MIQ.

22 APRIL 2021 - No incidents to report.

* As part of managing the changing risk profile of MIQ following the implementation of quarantine-free travel with Australia, an additional 500 rooms per fortnight (on top of MIQ's usual operating contingency) are being held back. This means a reduction in operational capacity from 4,500 to 4,000 rooms per fortnight.

** The MIAS Rooms Allocated (Orange line) reflects vouchers currently issued to people, including those travelling from Australia who have not cancelled their voucher. These vouchers are in the process of being cancelled.

Some vouchers are also not being released while the Pullman is operating at reduced levels and there is a pause on further returnees at the Grand Millennium and Grand Mercure facilities in Auckland. Vouchers set aside for Emergency Allocation and all currently allocated vouchers are not impacted by this decision.
