Preparing for the 2021 ACC Levy Round: Implementing Three-Yearly ACC Levy Rounds

Portfolio ACC

On 24 March 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV):

Frequency of levy rounds

- noted that on 11 December 2019, DEV agreed to set levies for one year only in 2020, and noted that officials will provide further advice to the Minister of Finance and the Minister for ACC on moving to a three-yearly levy setting cycle after the 2020 levy round [DEV-19-MIN-0348];
- 2 **noted** that on 1 July 2020, DEV agreed to roll over 2020/21 levy rates into 2021/22 due to the uncertainty caused by COVID-19 [DEV-20-MIN-0118];
- agreed to move to three-yearly ACC levy rounds from 2021 (with the first levies to apply from 2022/23);

Funding policy

- 4 **noted** that as a consequence of paragraph 3 above, minor and technical changes to the Funding Policy Statement will be required;
- agreed to amend the Funding Policy Statement from a levy-period basis to an annual basis;
- agreed to change the cap on levy increases to a 5 percent annual cap (in addition to inflation adjustments for the Motor Vehicle Account);
- agreed to correct the funding ratio calculation to align the Funding Policy Statement with the method ACC uses in calculating funding ratios in its reports, excluding the unexpired risk liability;

Funding Policy Statement

8 **noted** that the Funding Policy Statement will be gazetted immediately following Cabinet's decisions on three-yearly levy rounds and associated funding policy changes.
