Certification of Consumer Credit Providers Regulations

Portfolio Commerce and Consumer Affairs

On 15 April 2021, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 **noted** that on 17 March 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee agreed to various regulations that are necessary to support the implementation of the Credit Contracts Legislation Amendment Act 2019 [DEV-21-MIN-0032];
- 2 **noted** that the Credit Contracts and Consumer Finance (Certification) Amendment Regulations 2021 and the Financial Service Providers (Registration) Amendment Regulations 2021 give effect to or support the decisions referred to above;

 - 3.1 Credit Contracts and Consumer Finance (Certification) Amendment Regulations 2021 [PCO 23321/4.0];
 - 3.2 Financial Service Providers (Registration) Amendment Regulations 2021 [PCO 23704/4.0];
