Building Amendment Bill: Proposals for Regulations: Release of Discussion Document

Portfolio Building and Construction

On 14 April 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV):

- noted that there are systemic problems limiting the efficiency and quality of building work and preventing fair outcomes when things go wrong;
- **noted** that the Building (Building Products and Methods, Modular Components, and Other Matters) Amendment Bill (the Bill) proposes changes to:
 - 2.1 enable the creation of a new voluntary certification scheme for modular component manufacturers;
 - 2.2 introduce information requirements for building products;
 - 2.3 strengthen the product certification (CodeMark) scheme;
- 3 **noted** that regulations are required to implement the reforms proposed in the Bill;
- 4 **agreed** to the release of the discussion document *Building System Reform: Proposed Regulations for Building Product Information Requirements, Modular Component Manufacturers, and Product Certification* (the discussion document), attached to the paper under DEV-21-SUB-0072, for public consultation;
- authorised the Minister for Building and Construction to make minor amendments and refinements to the discussion document and supporting documents before they are released;
- 6 noted that the Minister for Building and Construction also intends to notify parties to the World Trade Organisation Technical Barriers to Trade Agreement of the proposed regulations;
- 7 **invited** the Minister for Building and Construction to report back to DEV in on the outcome of the consultation and seeking agreement to final policy proposals for building system regulations proposed under the Bill.
