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Background

- We have prepared a Cabinet paper for you to seek full policy decisions and approval to draft a Bill to implement a Fair Pay Agreements (FPA) system.
- On 26 March 2021 we provided you with a copy of the draft Cabinet paper for Ministerial
 consultation and requested any feedback on the draft Cabinet paper by 6 April 2021. The
 covering briefing provided a summary of the key matters raised by other government
 departments in relation to the proposed design of the FPA system and its implications [refer
 briefing 2021-2519].

We have updated the FPA Cabinet paper

- 3. We have updated the draft FPA Cabinet paper to reflect:
 - a. Recent Budget decisions
 - Feedback provided by your office
 - c. Additional comments provided by other government agencies
 - d. Our further internal review of the paper, including where we have suggested and obtained your approval for a change in policy.
- 4. Please note we are seeking to confirm a minor change to a policy decision as a result of a misalignment between the proposal in the body of a report about funding for the Screen sector and the wording of relevant recommendation. It was proposed that there be an additional funding contribution of up to \$25,000 to each bargaining side for occupational-level collective contracts under the SIWB, if less than 20% of those in coverage on their side is a member of a union or industry group [briefing 2021-2007 refers]. This recommendation was made in the body of briefing 2021-2007 to provide consistency with FPA bargaining support, and funding is included for this purpose in the FPA Budget allocation. Your agreement to the text in the Cabinet paper will be considered confirmation of your agreement to the clarification of the recommendation.
- 5. A version of the final Cabinet paper with these changes shown as track changes, and 'comments' providing explanations for the main changes, is attached in Annex One. A clean version with all changes accepted is attached as Annex Two.
- 6. The Regulatory Impact Statement prepared by MBIE is attached in Annex Three.
- We will provide your office with talking points for the DEV Committee meeting by Tuesday 13 April 2021.
