Future Pathways for the Research, Science and Innovation System: Release of Discussion Document

Portfolio Research, Science and Innovation

On 29 September 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV):

- 1 **noted** that on 19 May 2021, DEV:
 - 1.1 agreed to the preparation of a green paper discussion document that will set out a range of options for possible reform, including the development of a system for establishing a clear set of national research priorities and ensuring the research institutions are equipped to deliver on those priorities;
 - 1.2 invited the Minister of Research, Science and Innovation to report back on the progress of the green paper;

- 2 **noted** that the Future Pathways programme seeks to develop options to build a modern, fit for purpose, and future focused research system that is connected, adaptive and resilient;
- 3 **noted** that the proposed green paper is the first stage of this programme, does not precommit to any new initiatives or solutions, and seeks to start a wide ranging and deliberative conversation about the future of New Zealand's research system;
- 4 **agreed** to the release of the document entitled *Future Pathways: Green Paper on the Future* of the New Zealand Research System (the Green Paper), attached to the submission under DEV-21-SUB-0193, for public consultation, subject to any minor or technical amendments that may be required;
- 5 **noted** that the Green Paper will be released in October 2021;
- 6 **noted** that the consultation period will run from October 2021 to February 2022;
- 7 **invited** the Minister of Research, Science and Innovation to report back to DEV by mid-2022 with the outcomes of consultation and any proposed policy changes.
