Review of Financial Markets Authority Funding and Levy: Release of Discussion Document

Portfolio Commerce and Consumer Affairs

On 29 September 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV):

- **noted** that the Financial Markets Authority's remit is expanding, and that it will be responsible for monitoring and enforcing compliance with three new regulatory regimes, being:
 - 1.1 the conduct of financial institutions under the Financial Markets (Conduct of Institutions) Amendment Bill;
 - 1.2 the reform of insurance contract legislation under the Insurance Contract Law regime;
 - a framework for climate-related disclosures under the Financial Sector (Climate-related Disclosures and Other Matters) Amendment Bill;
- noted that the Financial Markets Authority requires additional funding from 2022/2023 to monitor and enforce compliance with the above regimes;
- noted that the discussion document 2021 Review of Financial Markets Authority Funding and Levy (the discussion document), attached to the paper under DEV-21-SUB-0196, outlines and seeks feedback on the Financial Market Authority's additional funding requirements, adjustments to the Financial Markets Authority levy, and implementation of the Conduct of Financial Institutions regime;
- 4 **agreed** to the release of the discussion document for public consultation, subject to any minor and technical changes that may be authorised by the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs;

Confidential advice to Government

invited the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to report back to DEV in early 2022 to seek approval for proposed policy changes to the Financial Markets Authority levy model.
