### Minimum Wage Order 2022

#### Portfolio Workplace Relations and Safety

On 17 February 2022, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- **noted** that on 1 February 2022, Cabinet agreed to increase the adult minimum wage rate from \$20.00 per hour to \$21.20 per hour, and to increase the starting-out and training minimum wage rates from \$16.00 per hour to \$16.96 per hour [CAB-22-MIN-0005];
- 2 **noted** that the Minimum Wage Order 2022 will give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- 3 **authorised** the submission to the Executive Council of the Minimum Wage Order 2022 [PCO 24545/2.0];
- 4 **noted** that the Minimum Wage Order 2022 will come into force on 1 April 2022.
