## **Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Michael Wood**

Portfolios Transport / Workplace Relations and Safety

On 4 April 2022, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Michael Wood from New Zealand from 11 to 19 to June 2022, to travel to:
  - 1.1 Oslo, Norway to represent New Zealand at the International Electric Vehicle Symposium and Exhibition;
  - 1.2 Geneva, Switzerland and London, the United Kingdom for engagements at the International Labour Organisation and bilateral discussions;
- 2 **agreed** that he be accompanied by one staff member from his office;
- 3 **approved** the estimated expenditure of up to \$54,600 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);
- 4 **noted** that he will be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment and the Ministry of Transport whose travel costs will be met by their departments;
- 5 **agreed** that in his absence:
  - 5.1 Hon Andrew Little act as Minister for Workplace Relations and Safety;
  - 5.2 Hon James Shaw act as Minister of Transport; 5.3 Hon Kiri Allan act as Deputy Leader of the House; 6 **noted** that the House is not sitting during his absence.
