Major Events Management (FIFA Women's World Cup Australia & New Zealand 2023) Order 2022

Portfolio Economic and Regional Development

On 25 August 2022, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 noted that the Minister for Economic and Regional Development (the Minister) recommends that the Governor General, by Order in Council, declare the FIFA Women's World Cup Australia & New Zealand 2023 to be a 'major event' and certain associated emblems and words to be 'major event emblems and words' under the Major Events Management Act 2007;
- 2 **noted** that, before recommending the making of an Order in Council, the Minister consulted with the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, the Minister for Sport and Recreation and other persons as required under sections 7 and 8 of the Major Events Management Act 2007;
- 3 **noted** that the Major Events Management (FIFA Women's World Cup Australia & New Zealand 2023) Order 2022 (the Order) gives effect to the recommendation referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- 4 **authorised** submission to the Executive Council of the Major Events Management (FIFA Women's World Cup Australia & New Zealand 2023) Order 2022 [PCO 24834/2.0];
- 5 **noted** that the Order comes into force on 29 September 2022.
