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Construction Contracts (Retention Money) Amendment Bill: Further Policy Decisions

Portfolio Building and Construction

On 9 February 2022, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

Background

- 1 **noted** that:
 - 1.1 the Construction Contracts (Retention Money) Amendment Bill (the Bill) makes changes to the retention money regime in the Construction Contracts Act 2002 to strengthen and clarify the existing requirements;
 - 1.2 the Bill was reported back to the House on 22 November 2021, and is awaiting its second reading;

Supplementary order paper

- agreed that the Chief Executive of the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment be given the function to investigate and enforce the newly introduced offences in the Bill, if the Chief Executive considers that it is desirable to do so;
- agreed that this retention money regime investigation and enforcement function be funded through the building levy;
- 4 **agreed** that the building levy be used to fund functions that will support the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment's retention money regime investigation and enforcement function, namely to:
 - 4.1 provide information and education on the retention money regime;
 - 4.2 monitor compliance with the retention money regime;
 - 4.3 provide advice to the Minister for Building and Construction on the retention money regime;

Legislative implications

authorised the Minister for Building and Construction to issue drafting instructions to the Parliamentary Counsel Office to give effect to the above paragraphs;

authorised the Minister for Building and Construction to make additional policy decisions and minor or technical changes, consistent with the policy intent of the above paragraphs, on issues that arise during the drafting of the Supplementary Order Paper and regulations.
