Offshore Renewable Energy: Release of Consultation Document on Approaches to Manage Feasibility Activities

Portfolio Energy and Resources

On 7 December 2022, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- noted that in May 2022, Cabinet agreed, through the release of Aotearoa New Zealand's first emissions reduction plan, to develop regulatory settings to enable investment in offshore renewable energy generation and innovation by July 2024 [CAB-22-MIN-0152];
- **noted** that public consultation on regulatory settings for offshore renewable energy will occur in two phases;
 - 2.1 Phase One in 2022/23 will focus on approaches to manage the feasibility stage of offshore renewable energy development;
 - 2.2 Phase Two in 2023 will involve consideration of broader regulatory settings required to enable the construction, operation, and maintenance, and decommissioning of offshore renewable energy infrastructure;
- **approved** the release of the discussion document *Enabling Investment in Offshore Renewable Energy* (the discussion document), attached to the paper under DEV-22-SUB-0299, subject to any minor or technical changes that may be approved by the Minister of Energy and Resources before its release;
- 4 **noted** that in 2023, the Minister of Energy and Resources intends to seek approval to consult on Phase Two, the broader regulatory settings needed to manage the construction, operation and maintenance, and decommissioning stages of offshore renewable energy development.
