Description of coverage currently proposed:

The initiating union applied for approval to initiate bargaining for a proposed fair pay agreement in the interurban, rural and urban bus transport industry. Included in the occupation is a list of ANZSCO occupational codes.

The initiating union relied on the 1,000 representation test.

The Ministry of Business Innovation and Employment (MBIE) is assessing the proposed coverage to ensure compliance with the Fair Pay Agreements Act 2022.
