How will the Minister differentiate when there is a clear issue of dual use i.e de-orbiting technology which can be used for clearing space debris which fits with New Zealand values, but equally can be used to aggressively de-orbit operational satellites? Ditto most high-resolution Earth observation systems, which fit with our values when used for applications such as disaster relief, firefighting and coral bleaching but also can be used for monitoring troop and armament movements in conflict zones.
