## **Adjusting Major Hazard Facilities Fee and Levy Rates**

## Portfolio Workplace Relations and Safety

On 4 May 2023, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 noted that in February 2023, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee agreed to adjust the fee and levy rates charged to major hazard facilities operators, to recover the costs of WorkSafe New Zealand's regulatory activity in overseeing the major hazard facilities regulatory regime [DEV-23-MIN-0005];
- 2 **noted** that the Health and Safety at Work (Major Hazard Facilities) Amendment Regulations 2023 give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- 3 **noted** that sections 215 and 217 of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 require the Minister for Workplace Relations and Safety to:
  - 3.1 consult with all persons and organisations that the Minister considers appropriate, given the subject matter of the regulations;
  - 3.2 consult with the Environmental Protection Authority, if the regulations relate to hazardous substances;
  - 3.3 receive advice from WorkSafe New Zealand on the proposed levy;
- 4 **noted** the advice of the Minister for Workplace Relations and Safety that the requirements in paragraph 3 have been met;
- 5 **noted** that the Health and Safety at Work (Major Hazard Facilities) Amendment Regulations 2023 come into force on 8 June 2023;
- 6 **authorised** the submission to the Executive Council of the Health and Safety at Work (Major Hazard Facilities) Amendment Regulations 2023 [PCO 25433/6.0].
