### Oral Item: Update on the Review of Government Investment in the Screen Sector

**Portfolio**                      **Arts, Culture and Heritage / Economic Development**

On 10 May 2023, the Cabinet Social Wellbeing Committee (SWC):

- 1        **noted** the update on the Review of Government Investment in the Screen Sector, which seeks to better support the development of a more balanced, resilient and sustainable New Zealand screen sector;
- 2        **noted** that there is heightened uncertainty in the sector, both domestically and internationally, which has been compounded by uncertainty from the Review;
- 3        **noted** that the Australian Government recently announced changes to their investment in the screen sector, placing further pressure on New Zealand's international competitiveness in the sector;
- 4        **invited** the Minister for Arts, Culture and Heritage and Minister for Economic Development to report back to SWC following the Budget 2023 moratorium with preferred options for improving the government's investment in, and support for, the screen sector.
