# Oral Item: Worker Redeployment Support Contingency - Rapid Response to Flooding

Portfolio Regional Economic Development

On 27 July 2020, following reference from the Cabinet Economic Development Committee, Cabinet:

- 1 **noted** that in March 2020, Cabinet agreed to a COVID-19 economic support package which included \$100 million for worker redeployment support [CAB-20-MIN-0108];
- 2 **agreed** to fund up to \$4 million from the Worker Redeployment package for worker redeployment and associated capital expenditure to address flood damage in Northland related to roads, culverts and drains and associated infrastructure;
- 3 **agreed** that funds will be allocated to the Provincial Development Unit to work with relevant bodies to hire workers and deliver repairs to the flood water damage;
- 4 **invited** the Minister of Finance and Minister or Regional Economic Development to report back to Cabinet on the proposed disbursement mechanism before the funds are granted;
- 5 **authorised** the Minister of Finance and Minister for Regional Economic Development jointly to agree to any necessary changes to appropriations to implement the above decisions.
