# Energy (Fuels, Levies, and References) Amendment Bill: Approval for Introduction

#### Portfolio Energy and Resources

On 6 April 2023, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 noted that the Energy (Fuels, Levies, and References) Amendment Bill (the Bill) will amend the statutory purpose of the petroleum or engine fuel monitoring levy so that the levy can be used to fund onshore fuel resilience initiatives, such as government procurement of services relating to storage and management of reserve fuel stocks;
- 2 **approved** the Energy (Fuels, Levies, and References) Amendment Bill [PCO 25231/3.0] for introduction, subject to the final approval of the government caucus and sufficient support in the House of Representatives;
- 3 **agreed** that the Bill be introduced on 18 May 2023 (Budget night) and passed through all stages under urgency.
