Update on Tourism New Zealand's Role in Domestic Demand

Portfolio Tourism

On 3 May 2023, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- 1 noted that on 16 December 2020, the Cabinet Business Committee agreed that Tourism New Zealand's role be expanded to include domestic marketing throughout the COVID-19 response [CBC-20-MIN-0132];
- 2 **noted** that a review of Tourism New Zealand's domestic function has now been completed;
- 3 **noted** that the review does not consider it to be an appropriate ongoing role for the government to encourage spend in one demand-driven sector over others;
- 4 **noted** that the Minister of Tourism has agreed that Tourism New Zealand will stop domestic marketing activity from 1 July 2023 and return to international marketing only;
- 5 **noted** that the Minister of Tourism will have the ability to reactivate the domestic function in the event of an extreme shock;
- 6 **invited** the Minister of Tourism to consult Cabinet colleagues in the event of an extreme shock warranting the reactivation of Tourism New Zealand's domestic marketing function;
- 7 **noted** that the Minister of Tourism will provide advice to Extreme Weather Recovery Ministers as appropriate on tourism-related initiatives that could be implemented in the Thames/Coromandel area or other areas severely affected by the recent weather events.
