Portfolio Immigration

On 27 July 2023, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- noted that, on 5 May 2023, the Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade Committee presented its report to the House, titled Petition of Democracy for Myanmar Working Group New Zealand: Emergency rescue for Myanmar refugees (family members of New Zealand residents);
- 2 **noted** that in this report, the Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade Committee made one recommendation, relating to the Minister of Immigration commissioning work on a specific immigration response to the humanitarian situation in Myanmar;
