#### **Purpose**

#### **Background**

- 1. On 8 November 2021, Cabinet agreed to amend the COVID-19 Public Health Response (Managed Isolation and Quarantine Charges) Regulations 2020, to include a Ministerial class waiver power for groups of people included in the Afghanistan resettlement response [CAB-12-MIN-0454 refers].
- 2. To give effect to those decisions, you took the following paper to the Cabinet Legislation Committee on 9 December 2021:
  - COVID-19 Public Health Response (Managed Isolation and Quarantine Charges) Amendment Regulations (No 5) 2021.
- 3. The Amendment Regulations came into effect on 13 December 2021.

#### **Proactive release**

- 4. MBIE recommends the proactive release of the Cabinet paper (Annex 1) and the Cabinet Minute LEG 21-MIN-0214 (Annex 2) without any redactions.
- 5. MBIE requires at least 3-5 working days to publish Cabinet material to mbie.govt.nz, following a due diligence process and having obtained your approval to the release of material.
