## **Building (Dam Safety) Amendment Regulations 2023**

## Portfolio Building and Construction

On 17 August 2023, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 noted that in February 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV) agreed to policy decisions for a set of Dam Safety Regulations for the post-construction safe management of dams in New Zealand [DEV-21-MIN-0008];
- 2 **noted** that in May 2022, the Cabinet Legislation Committee authorised the submission to the Executive Council of the Building (Dam Safety) Regulations 2022, to come into force on 13 May 2024 [LEG-22-MIN-0052];
- **noted** that in February 2021, DEV authorised the Minister for Building and Construction to make decisions, consistent with the proposals in these recommendations on any issues which arise during the drafting process, and minor, technical and timing changes to these proposals as required [DEV-21-MIN-0008];
- 4 **noted** that the dam classification certificate prescribed by the Building (Dam Safety) Regulations 2022 contains two unnecessary fields of flood performance and earthquake performance, which will significantly increase time and cost to complete the classification;
- 5 **noted** that the Minister for Building and Construction approved a minor and technical change to the Building (Dam Safety) Regulations 2022 to remove the fields for flood performance and earthquake performance from form 1 of Schedule 3 of the Building (Dam Safety) Regulations 2022, which is consistent with the original policy proposals;
- 6 **agreed** that the Building (Dam Safety) Amendment Regulations 2023 include the minor and technical change outlined in paragraph 5;
- 7 **noted** that the Minister for Building and Construction authorised the Parliamentary Counsel Office to draft the amendments without reference to Cabinet, as these are minor and technical changes consistent with the original policy intent;
- 8 **noted** that the Building (Dam Safety) Amendment Regulations 2023 will give effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 6 above;
- 9 **authorised** the submission to the Executive Council of the Building (Dam Safety) Amendment Regulations 2023 [PCO 25678/3.0];
- 10 **noted** that the Building (Dam Safety) Amendment Regulations 2023 come into force on 21 September 2023.
