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Tāwhaki Proposal Exception Request for Regional Strategic Partnership Fund (RSPF) Consideration

Portfolio Regional Development

On 28 August 2023, Cabinet:

- 1 **noted** that the Regional Strategic Partnership Fund (RSPF) is a \$200 million fund established in 2021 which seeks to help grow regional economies by investing in their regional economic development (RED) priorities;
- 2 noted that Tāwhaki is a Māori-Crown partnership between Te Taumutu Rūnanga and Wairewa Rūnanga (together as Kaitorete Limited) and the Crown [CAB-21-MIN-0193];
- 3 noted Commercial Information

ut that Tāwhaki is now seeking \$5.4 million in grant funding from the RSPF to build a sealed runway and a hangar in the shorter term;

- 4 **noted** that the Tāwhaki proposal does not meet the Cabinet agreed RSPF location eligibility criteria as it is located inside the Christchurch city area (at Kaitorete Spit);
- 5 **noted** that despite not meeting location criteria, this proposal would progress research and development, support Māori aspirations and align with Government space strategies as well as wider Government strategies;
- 6 **noted** that RED Ministers consider that the strategic and economic benefits of this proposal outweigh the risks and that these benefits would not be achieved without investment;
- 7 noted that at the 24 August 2023 RED meeting Ministers agreed to approve funding for the Tāwhaki proposal, subject to Cabinet agreement to provide an exception to the locationbased RSPF eligibility criteria;
- 8 **agreed** to provide an exception to the location-based RSPF eligibility criteria to enable RSPF investment of \$5.4 million in the Tāwhaki proposal;
- 9 noted that this investment is subject to Kānoa Regional Development & Investment Unit (Kānoa) being satisfied that:
