Enabling Not-for-Profit Charter Schools to Access All of Government Contracts

Portfolio Economic Growth

On 26 March 2025, the Cabinet Economic Policy Committee:

- noted that allowing not-for-profit charter schools access to the All of Government (AoG) contracts could benefit the government and the taxpayer through reduced risk and cost savings;
- **noted** that allowing not-for-profit charter schools access to AoG contracts would be broadly consistent with the current eligibility framework and criteria set by Cabinet;
- agreed to define not-for-profit charter schools as eligible to use the AoG contracts;
- **agreed** that not-for-profit charter schools be able to access AoG contracts from the date on which Cabinet approves the paper under ECO-25-SUB-0024.
