Building and Construction (Small Stand-alone Dwellings) Amendment Bill: Approval for Introduction

Portfolio Building and Construction

On 15 May 2025, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 **noted** that the Building and Construction (Small Stand-alone Dwellings) Amendment Bill (the Bill) holds a category 5 priority on the 2025 Legislation Programme (to proceed to select committee by the end of 2025);
- 2 **agreed** that the Bill now holds a category 3 priority (a priority to be passed by the end of 2025);
- 3 **noted** that the Bill will remove regulatory barriers and make it easier to build small standalone dwellings;
- 4 **noted** that the Minister for Building and Construction has approved minor and technical policy changes to the Bill, as set out in Appendix One of the paper under LEG-25-SUB-0081;
- 5 **approved** the Building and Construction (Small Stand-alone Dwellings) Amendment Bill [PCO 27106/3.0] for introduction;
- 6 **authorised** the Parliamentary Counsel Office to make any minor or technical amendments to the Bill prior to Cabinet;
- 7 **agreed** that the Bill be introduced on a date to be approved by the Leader of the House;
- 8 **agreed** that the Government propose that the Bill be referred to the Transport and Infrastructure Committee for consideration.
