### Auckland Consolidated Central Government Work Programme

On 14 May 2025, the Cabinet Economic Policy Committee (ECO):

- 1        **noted** the wide range and scope of central government initiatives in Auckland that were initiated, progressed, or completed in 2024 calendar year, as set out in Annex One attached to the submission under ECO-25-SUB-0068;
- 2        **noted** that the initiatives cover economic and infrastructure, social, cultural, and environmental and conservation domains;
- 3        **noted** that ECO previously invited the Minister for Auckland to report back every six months on the cross-government work programme in Auckland [ECO-24-MIN-0108];
- 4        **noted** that the Minister for Auckland intends to directly work with relevant Ministers to effectively and efficiently progress the cross-government work programme;
- 5        **invited** the Minister for Auckland to report back to relevant Ministers (rather than ECO) at least once every six months on the cross-government work programme in Auckland;
- 6        **agreed** to provide the Minister for Auckland with a mandate to seek information on central government Auckland-related initiatives directly from relevant agencies, to fulfil the advocacy and coordination roles of the Auckland portfolio and meet Cabinet report back commitments.
